ARCA Unofficial Working Hunter Day
Have a Go!
Saturday June 13th

Parkerville Equestrian Centre
Seaborne Street PARKERVILLE (see directions on entry form)

As this is an unofficial day rules have been modified to suit as we would like everyone to have a go! The first phase is the Jumping Phase. There will then be a Flat Phase (hacking workout) followed by an In-Hand Phase. **You MUST be a current member of an ARCA club to compete.**

Classes are listed below:

1. Poles on the ground, Walk Trot only (not eligible to compete in any Walk Trot Canter classes)
- 1A. Poles on the ground, Walk Trot Canter (canter in both poles and workout)
2. 45cm, Walk Trot Only (not eligible to compete in any Walk Trot Canter classes)
- 2A. 45cm, Walk Trot Canter (canter in both jumps and workout)
3. 60cm
4. 75cm and over

Jumping Phase: Judge Diane Bennit

The course consists of 8 jumps (equal number of verticals and spreads). You are given a score for each obstacle cleared and a score for style and manners.

Flat Phase (Hacking): Judge TBA

The workout will be similar to a show hunter class but will include an extended canter for classes 3 and onwards. Classes 1 & 2 will have a walk and trot work option if they wish. You will be awarded marks on action and temperament.

In Hand Phase: Judge TBA

You will untack your horse (saddle only) and present it to the judge for marking on type and conformation - you do not run the horse out ONLY present to the judge.

COMPETITION DAY RULES:

- Crops to be no longer than 75cm
- Running martingales are not permitted.
- Horses or Ponies must be 4 years of age and over
- Dummy spurs are permitted
- Disobedience in any phase will result in penalties
- The same saddle must be used for both phases
- Both phases must be ridden in a snaffle bridle

PRESENTATION OF HORSE AND SADDLERY:

- **Manes and Tails:** Manes can be plaited; tails can be plaited or pulled. Not compulsory as this is an unofficial day.
- **Coat and Hooves:** Coat must be clean. Hooves can be oiled or blackened. No quarter markers or make up is permitted.
- **Saddle:** Saddle should be of good quality, clean and have sound stitching. It may be more “workmanlike” than for a ridden show class. A straight flapped, all purpose or jumping saddle may be used. Western, Half Breed and Stock saddles are also permitted.
- **Other Gear:** Crupper and breast plates are also permitted.
- **Saddlecloth:** Your normal club saddle cloth or a sheepskin saddle cloth matching the shape of the saddle is acceptable.
- **Girth:** Girth can be cotton, leather or synthetic
- **Bridle:** Bridle should be the same colour as the saddle, supple, of good quality leather. Stitching on noseband and brow band is optional.
- **Brow bands:** A Working Hunter should normally wear a snaffle bridle with a plain browband and nose band. No coloured or fancy brow bands.
- **Rider's Attire:** Your club uniform. Gloves should be plain and match the rider's boots. Clothing should fit well and be comfortable to ride in. **ALL** riders to wear an approved safety helmet, for both sections.

ENTRY FEE

- \$50.00 per horse and rider combination. This comprises of \$40.00 for first round plus the \$10 day membership fee. Zamia ARC members do not have to pay the \$10.00 fee. Day Competition form must be completed. ARCA membership cards/number must be supplied or sighted.
- Second round \$30.00 – maximum two classes per horse – can be same height or consecutive – please note second round does not require an in-hand phase – your previous mark will apply. Only one score will count for those entered in same height events – the highest score will be awarded towards placing.
- Prizes for 1st – 3rd ribbons to 6th place.

There will be a canteen available on the day.

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Zamia Adult Riding Club (Inc) is an EWA affiliate. Riders who are NOT direct members of EWA are able to compete at designated events run by Zamia ARC (Inc) as determined by the Committee, by becoming a Competition Member.

Competition Members are not eligible for election to the Committee, do not have the right to nominate a person for election to the Committee and cannot vote at any meetings of the Club/Association. Protection is afforded to the member under the Club's Public & Products Liability Insurance while participating at the designated event where they are liable for bodily injury or property damage to a third party. It does NOT provide Personal Accident Insurance cover.

It is important to note that any liability claim for causing bodily injury or property damage to a third party whilst attending a designated event results in a \$2,500 excess. This excess is payable by the person held liable for the damage.

It is compulsory to wear a safety standard approved riding helmet (approval Nos: AS/NZS-3838, Euro EN 1384, US-ASTN F1163) and smooth-soled and heeled riding boots when mounted on a horse at all ZAMIA ARC (Inc) club events.
