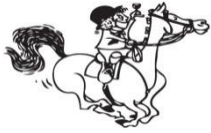

### **Conditions & Information**

WTC = Walk Trot and Canter    WT = Walk Trot    OTT = Off The Track

Club presentation to take place at 9am sharp before commencing the other classes and rings.  
PCAWA approved gear and bits, No double bridles to be worn, single bit and single rein only.  
Gear checking will take place.

### **Amended Program**

We recognise the need for smaller classes and timely events, therefore we have tailored this program based on previous entries to ARCA challenges. This program reflects ARCA's demographic horse type and as a result we expect it to be a balanced program catering for the ARCA audience.

We are offering **Hack & Hunter rings** in an attempt to have even numbers in each ring and to speed up the day. You can enter either the Hack or Hunter classes, not both. Likewise you can enter either the Walk Trot or Walk Trot Canter classes, not both.

An added inclusion to this program is the Off the Track classes in each height bracket. These classes are open to those who are competing on a retired Thoroughbred or Standardbred racehorse. If you intend entering these classes please supply your horse's race name on the entry form. If the race name is unknown, please supply the brands of the horse. There will be a Champion class for WT and WTC Thoroughbreds and WT and WTC Standardbreds. OTT entries are eligible for all other classes. OTT champions are not eligible for Supreme Champion (as you're able to enter all the classes which are) and do not count towards overall club points. OTT classes are sponsored by Racing and Wagering WA's Off the Track program

**Organisers reserve the right to cancel, combine or create additional classes as we see fit.**

### **Helpers**

Each club entered will be given a helper times and duties; it is up to your club to delegate the duty to individuals from the club. It may require a non-riding member to perform duties during the day while others are riding.

### **Dress**

All entrants are to wear their club uniform. Plaiting is advised. Australian Standard approved safety helmet and boots are compulsory. Tack must be clean and safe, random checks will take place.

### Club Turn Out/Presentation Award - 9am

The best presented club award will require a minimum of 2, maximum of 6 horses and riders from a club to present a uniform front with clean horses, gear and appearance. One team per club only, select your best 6 if you have more than 6 members entered. The judging will take place at the beginning of the day before all other classes commence.

### Judging

Our judges will be advised to judge the majority of the classes on the ring with the exception of a few classes requiring individual workouts. The judges' decision is final.

### Supremes

The Supreme Walk Trot Canter class will consist of the ALL of the Walk Trot Canter Champions from all height brackets and Hack or Hunter classes. This will be held at the conclusion of all of the rings and will take place in Ring 1.

The Supreme Walk Trot class will consist of the ALL of the Walk Trot Champions from all height brackets and Hack or Hunter classes. This will be held at the conclusion of all of the rings and take place in Ring 2.

The Champion Walk Trot and Walk Trot Canter OTT Thoroughbred and Standardbred classes will consist of those who placed 1<sup>st</sup> in their OTT classes from all height brackets and Hack or Hunter classes. These will be held before the Supreme classes in Ring 1.

### Confused as to which ring to enter?

Here are a few questions to help

Firstly ask yourself if you are confident to canter in a large group? If not then the Walk Trot rings are for you.

Secondly, is your horse a Hack or a Hunter?

You should enter the **Hack** ring if your horse a finer or lighter boned type horse. Do any of these words describe your horse; flashy, pretty, light on his feet, nimble, elegant. Breed examples Arabs, Riding Ponies, light Thoroughbreds.

You should enter the **Hunter** ring if your horse is a bigger or heavier boned horse. Do any of these words describe your horse; work horse, plodder, strong, solid, powerful mover, noble, handsome. Breed examples Welsh, Connemara, Draft, Friesian., heavy Warmbloods.

Protection is afforded to the member under the Club's Public & Products Liability Insurance while participating at the designated event where they are liable for bodily injury or property damage to a third party. It does NOT provide Personal Accident Insurance cover.*

*It is important to note that any liability claim for causing bodily injury or property damage to a third party whilst attending a designated event results in a \$2,500 excess. This excess is payable by the person held liable for the damage.*

*It is compulsory to wear a safety standard approved riding helmet (approval Nos: AS/NZS-3838, Euro EN 1384, US-ASTN F1163) and smooth-soled and heeled riding boots when mounted on a horse at all XYZ ARC (Inc) club events.*
